What makes a disciple?

Luke 6

Jesus went out to the mountain to pray...

Luke 4:42/Mark 1:35; Luke 5:16; Luke 6:12

Luke 5:16 “*He often withdrew to deserted places and prayed.*”

How well do we follow Jesus’ example of prayer?

1. When we are overwhelmed, do we turn to God in solitude and quietness for refreshment?
2. Do we withdraw to pray?
3. Do we pray OFTEN!?

The more important direction of flow in our prayer life is US hearing HIS VOICE, not Him hearing ours... get away, get focused... LISTEN!
