*John 10:18-19 I’m not speaking about all of you; I know those I have chosen. But the Scripture must be fulfilled: The one who eats My bread has raised his heel against Me. 19 “I am telling you now before it happens, so that when it does happen you will believe that **I am** He.*

*Matt 26:22 ...“Surely not I, **Lord?**”*

*Matt 26:25 Then Judas, replied, “Surely not I, Rabbi?”*

When do we “betray”? When do we fail to serve?

**When we do not acknowledge Jesus as Lord.**

High Priestly Prayer:

John 16:4

*...so that the Scripture may be fulfilled.*

Gethsemane – Gat-shamman – “Oil Press”

*“Pray that you may not enter into temptation.”*

*If it is possible, let this **cup** pass from Me. Yet not as I will, but as You will.”*

Judas: *“Greetings, Rabbi!” and kissed Him.*

*John 18:6 When He told them, “**I am** He,” they stepped back and fell to the ground.*

*Phil 2:10-11*

*Am I not to drink the cup the Father has given Me?”*

*John 18:56 But all this has happened so that the prophetic Scriptures would be fulfilled.”*
