Christ lives in us.

Sin has no dominion over us.

The world is dead to us.

IF I have been crucified with Christ so that I am “justified” – as if I had never sinned – and Christ lives in me...

AND, my old self was crucified so that sins dominion is abolished

AND, the world has been crucified to me and I to the world

Then WHY do I still sin?

One aspect: crucifixion produces death gradually...

Gal 5:17-25

24 “Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.”

God has positioned us for victory:

Gal 2 - Crucified with Christ, we are justified as having never sinned and identified with Christ...

Rom 6 - Crucified with Christ so that sin’s dominion is abolished and we are no longer enslaved to sin...

Gal 6 - the world has been crucified to us.

It’s not that we CANNOT sin...

It’s that we can NOT sin.
