Old Testament Prophecies about the Messiah:

Gen 12:3b “*all the peoples on earth will be blessed through you.*”

Gen 22 – willing sacrifice of a son

Exodus 12 – the Passover Lamb

2 Samuel – the Messiah, the Christ, will be a descendant of David.

Psalm 2 – the Messiah would be called God’s Son

Psalm 118 – “Blessed is He Who comes in the Name of the Lord”

“Christmas prophecies”:

Isaiah 7:14

Isaiah 9:6-7

Micah 5:2

Other prophecies:

Isaiah 35:5-7 – signs of healing

Isaiah 40:3-5 – preceded by a forerunner

Malachi 3:1 – preceded by a messenger

Isaiah 42:6-7 – light for the nations (Gentiles)

Isaiah 52:13-53:12 – suffering servant

Isaiah 61:1-2 – redemptive deeds

Daniel 7:13-14 – “Son of Man” - AUTHORITY!
