

# God Created Us to be With Him

- Psalm 100:3 Know that the LORD is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture.
- Psalm 140: 13 Surely the righteous shall give thanks to Your name; The upright shall dwell in Your presence. (NKJV)



# Our Sins Separate Us From God

- Isaiah 59:2 But your iniquities have separated you from your God; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.
- Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,
- Romans 6:23a - For the wages of sin [is] death;

# Sins Cannot Be Removed by Good Deeds

- Titus 3:4-6 <sup>4</sup> But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, <sup>5</sup> he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, <sup>6</sup> whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior

# Sins Cannot Be Removed by Good Deeds (cont.)

- Isaiah 64:<sup>6</sup> All of us have become like something unclean,  
and all our righteous acts are like a polluted garment;  
all of us wither like a leaf, and our iniquities carry us away like the wind.
- Eph 2:<sup>8</sup> For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—<sup>9</sup> **not by works**, so that no one can boast.
- Romans 3: 20a For by works of the law no human being will be justified in his sight,

# Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again.

- Romans 5:<sup>8</sup> But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!
- I John 2:<sup>2</sup> He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not only for ours, but also for those of the whole world.

# Paying the price for sin, Jesus died and rose again. (cont.)

- 1 Cor 15:3-4 <sup>3</sup> For I passed on to you as most important what I also received:  
that Christ died for our sins  
according to the Scriptures,  
<sup>4</sup> that He was buried,  
that He was raised on the third day  
according to the Scriptures,

- John 3:16 “For God loved the world in this way: He gave His One and Only Son, so that **everyone** who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life.
- 1 John 4:15 If **anyone** acknowledges that Jesus is the Son of God, God lives in them and they in God.

# Everyone who trusts in Him alone has eternal life.

- Acts 2:21 And **everyone** who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.
- Romans 10:13 for, "**Everyone** who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
- Acts 10:43 43 All the prophets testify about him that **everyone** who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name."

- Acts 4:12 Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved.”
- John 6: 40a For my Father’s will is that **everyone** who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life...”


