1 John 5:16-17

- *16 If anyone sees his brother committing a sin that does not bring death, he should ask, and God will give life to him—to those who commit sin that doesn't bring death. There is sin that brings death. I am not saying he should pray about that. 17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin that does not bring death.*

1 John 3:14

- *We know that we have passed from death to life because we love our brothers. The one who does not love remains in death.*

1 John 5:16a

- *16 If anyone sees his brother committing a sin that does not bring death, he should ask, and God will give life to him—to those who commit sin that doesn't bring death.*

1 John 3:9

- *Everyone who has been born of God does not sin, because His seed remains in him; he is not able to sin, because he has been born of God.*

1 John 5:16b

- *17 All unrighteousness is sin, and there is sin that does not bring death.*

- *...confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you may be healed. The urgent request of a righteous person is very powerful in its effect.*
